Minn is an experienced arbitrator and arbitration practitioner. He was the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and Registrar of the Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) from 2008 to 2013, and before that, a Director at the Ministry of Trade and Industry Singapore, with oversight for Singapore's trade agreements and World Trade Organisation-related matters, including policy review, formulation and negotiations. Prior to MTI, Minn was in private legal practice, specializing in dispute resolution including international arbitration. As CEO and Registrar of SIAC, Minn oversaw the operations of the Centre, and headed the legal team, which has charge of the administration of all cases filed with SIAC. As Registrar, he reviewed every draft arbitration award and emergency arbitrator's award that was issued by SIAC. He was also involved in the drafting of the 2010 and 2013 editions of the SIAC Rules, and assisted the Chairman and President of the SIAC Court of Arbitration in the appointment of arbitrators and emergency arbitrators. He was Singapore's representative to the UNCITRAL Working Group for the 2010 UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules. He also advised on the drafting of the Myanmar Arbitration Law 2016.

Minn has been appointed a panelist for WTO disputes between WTO member states. He has also sat as a sole arbitrator and member of arbitral tribunals in various international commercial disputes.

Minn has presented papers and spoken at numerous conferences and seminars on international arbitration and international trade. He has also written and is co-author of several articles on international arbitration, competition policy and trade agreements.
