Arbitration Experience

Although most of Lockheed Martin's work was for the US government, Mr. Smith focused much of his time and effort on large commercial disputes involving high-tech hardware and software products and services and related intellectual property issues. These included cases before the ICC, the AAA/ICDR and the LCIA, involving complex, high-value technologies with claims from around US\$10 million to hundreds of millions of dollars. Since taking early retirement from Lockheed Martin in 2011, Mr. Smith has served on arbitration panels conducted by SIAC (two cases involving claims and counterclaims exceeding US \$200 million), ICC, LCIA and ICDR. He also serves as counsel for parties in major arbitration proceedings. Mr. Smith co-chairs the arbitration/litigation special business team of Interlaw, a network of law firms in 70 countries rated "Band 1" by Chambers.

Mr. Smith's attention to effective case management techniques has resulted in significant cost savings while achieving outstanding results.
