SIAC Signs Memorandum of Understanding with the Korea In-House Counsel Association

The Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) is pleased to announce that it has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Korea In-House Counsel Association (KICA) to promote international arbitration as a preferred method of dispute resolution for resolving international disputes.

Under the MOU, SIAC and KICA will explore jointly organising conferences, seminars and workshops on international arbitration in Korea and Singapore; providing marketing support for each other's international arbitration events in Korea; and granting complimentary admission to each other's paid or members-only events, training courses and workshops in Korea.
