Alain Farhad is a French qualified lawyer (*Avocat à la Cour*) and a member of the New York Bar. He holds law degrees from Paris Sorbonne University and Cornell Law School. He is based in Dubai and heads Mayer Brown’s International Arbitration practice in the Middle East. Prior to relocating to the Middle East, he practiced international arbitration in Paris.

He has acted as sole arbitrator, co-arbitrator or Chairman in over 80 arbitration proceedings conducted under the rules of various international institutions. He has also advised and represented as an advocate corporations, States and State-owned entities in commercial, construction and investment protection treaty disputes for over 15 years.

Among other accolades, he has been recognized as “*one of the rising stars of international arbitration*”, “*exceptionally competent*”, “*a standout individual who is a true expert in international arbitration.*” (legal 500), and a “*Global Leader*” in international arbitration (Who’s Who of International Arbitration).

He has been appointed to serve as a member of the ICC Commission on Arbitration and ADR and serves in the task force on “Addressing issues of corruption in international arbitration” and in the task force on “Expedited procedure provisions”. He has previously served several terms as a member of the Steering Committee of the ICC UAE Arbitration Commission. He is currently member of the arbitration committee of the DIFC Courts.

He has written extensively on various aspects of arbitration law, in French and in English and is regularly invited to speak at a variety of international arbitration conferences globally.

He is fluent in English, French and Farsi.

Experience as Arbitrator

Alain Farhad has acted as an arbitrator (sole arbitrator, chairman or co-arbitrator) in over 80 arbitration proceedings under the rules of the ICC, DIAC, LCIA, and DIFC-LCIA as well as in *ad hoc* arbitration proceedings, including proceedings under the UNCITRAL rules. Some of his pending and recent appointments include:

- Appointed by DIAC upon the Claimant's nomination in an arbitration arising from the construction of a hotel in Dubai with claims exceeding USD 1 billion.
- Appointed by DIAC upon the Claimant's nomination in an arbitration arising from the construction of an electrical substation in the United Arab Emirates with claims exceeding USD 300 million.
- Appointed by the ICC Court upon the joint nomination of the co-arbitrators to act as the Chairman of the Arbitral Tribunal in an ICC arbitration seated in London between a Dutch contractor and an Iraqi State owned oil company.

- Appointed by the ICC Court to act the sole arbitrator in an arbitration seated in Doha and governed by the ICC Expedited Procedure Rules and Qatari law to decide a commercial dispute between a Qatari entity and a Spanish contractor.
- Appointed by the co-arbitrators to act as the Chairman of a DIFC-LCIA Arbitral Tribunal in arbitration proceedings seated in the DIFC and governed by UAE law arising in relation to a distribution agreement between a South Korean manufacturer of electronic equipment and its regional distributor.
- Appointed jointly by the parties to an LCIA arbitration seated in London to act as the sole arbitrator in a commercial dispute governed by English law between a Bahraini entity and an Emirati entity arising in relation to the sale of commodities in the oil and gas industry.
- Appointed by DIAC to serve as the emergency arbitrator in the second claim ever made under the DIAC rules emergency arbitrator provisions.
- Appointed by the co-arbitrators to act as the Chairman of the Arbitral Tribunal in a Dubai seated DIAC arbitration governed by UAE law arising in relation to the construction of a major hospital in the UAE.
