Glenn George Cheng has close to 30 years to date in private legal practice, during which he has served as a partner in Singapore, UK and US based global law firms. Today, Glenn is the founding director of (the) Chambers of GG Cheng & CE Lee LLC (GGCLaw), an independent set of chambers in which he maintains an exclusively client-customised, specialist practice as trusted advisor, contract draftsman and negotiator, arbitrator, and international arbitration counsel. At this stage of his career, Glenn has been involved in leading and advocating cases, as well as (in) advising multi-disciplinary projects worldwide which cumulatively exceed US\$20bn in aggregated value.

Glenn has a singular industry reputation in terms of complex projects including PPP/DBOO(T) infrastructure development projects, privately funded built-environment developments, energy exploration and production projects, and large-scale blue-water heavy civil, marine engineering, and ports construction projects.

Since 2014 Glenn has been involved in advising the land reclamation and infrastructure expansion of various sections of Singapore' western seaboard, from the Jurong Island Westward Expansion (JIWE) project, to acting for numerous JV-based head contractors on the Tuas Terminal "*Mega-Port*" Project.

Tuas Terminal is Singapore's pride and at 65mil TEUs handling capacity p.a, it will stand when completed, as the world's largest automated port facility. Glenn's tenure on the Tuas Terminal "*Mega-Port*" Project is approaching its 10th year and constitutes by far, the longest uninterrupted tenure of any international (and/or domestic) lawyer advising on that project.

In other forms of infrastructure, he has acted on BOT/DBOO(T), ports and refinery terminal construction projects in Abu Dhabi, Indonesia, India, Philippines, and Saudi Arabia. In energy projects, Glenn has acted in oil and gas MODU rig new-buildings, RLEC works, asset sale and purchases; as well as in shipyard-based EPC(I)(C) asset fabrication contracts. He is also well-known for his work on subsea drilling support engineering services contracts, as well as in non-oil-and-gas submarine cable EPC projects.

Separately, in terms of advising and acting in resolving contentious issues (without invocation of formal proceedings) Glenn was appointed to advise the resolution of over 400 claims and disputes which arose during the winding down of a crude oil and petrochemical trading division of the Indonesian national oil and gas authority. From 2016 to date, Glenn has been involved in advising a major EPA-ENX-listed Italian EPC multi-national

corporation in respect of its mid-and downstream oil and gas, petrochemicals and infrastructure projects across Africa, Malaysia, and the Philippines.

During the COVID-19 pandemic “lockdown” periods internationally, Mr Cheng advised numerous key clients and projects across Italy, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and the UAE.
