SIAC Signs Memorandum of Understanding with the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators

The Singapore International Arbitration Centre (**SIAC**) is pleased to announce that it has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (**MOU**) with the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (**Ciarb**) today to promote international arbitration as a preferred method of dispute resolution for resolving international disputes.
