The Right Honourable Beverley McLachlin PC CC

The Right Honourable Beverley McLachlin PC CC was the first female Chief Justice of Canada, and also the longest serving Chief Justice in the country, retiring in December 2017 after 28 years at the Supreme Court of Canada. She is considered by many to be among the finest legal minds in the history of the Supreme Court. She is currently a member of the King's Privy Council for Canada, as well as a non-permanent member of the Court of Final Appeal in Hong Kong, and an International Judge of the Singapore International Commercial Court.

Justice McLachlin's memoir "Truth be Told: My Journey Through Life and the Law" was published in 2019 and won the Shaughnessy Cohen Prize for Political Writing in 2020. She has also written two novels.
